You should be aware that there are Maths exams on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> March for all Year 11 students (some boys will sit a further Unit 1 re-take on the 7<sup>th</sup> March).

There are no further re-sits for these exams as the specification that the boys are following stops in March. As it is their last chance to sit this exam, it is essential that every student is present for them (even if they feel poorly!).

During half-term next week a Maths revision workshop is taking place in school on Monday 13<sup>th</sup> February, starting at 9.30 a.m. and finishing at 2.30 p.m. We would like all Year 11 boys to attend this as it will help to boost their Maths grade.

On the reverse of this document is a suggested revision timetable for the half-term break for your son. It involves completing a past paper and identifying three areas of weakness. Your son should then try and improve these weaknesses by using a combination of the resources listed on the next page. It is vital that your son works throughout the week and prepares properly for these important exams.
